The Johnson Crusaders boys' tennis team qualified for their eighth straight NJSIAA State Team Tournament in 2007, earning the #6 seed in Central, Group II. It will mark the third straight postseason that the Crusaders are seeded sixth. The streak began in 2000, with ALJ dropping a 5-0 affair to the eventual North II, Group II champs West Essex. In 2001, ALJ was seeded #3 and received a quarterfinal home match, dropping a close 4-1 match to Chatham. In 2002, the last time Johnson took on the same opponent in the quarters two years in a row, ALJ lost 4-1 at Chatham. In 2003, ALJ was seeded #4 and won their first State Playoff match in over a decade, 3-2 over Madison at the JTC before dropping a 3-0 semi-final match to Summit. Johnson has never won a State Championship in their history. For the last two seasons, ALJ dropped quarterfinal matches to the eventual champions Rumson Fair Haven. Johnson returns five starters from last season's squad that finished 8-7 and earned a berth into their seventh straight NJSIAA State Team Tournament. Johnson has been eliminated by the eventual champion in four of the seven previous seasons.

COACH PROFILE

Head Coach: Craig D'Amico
1st year (10-4)

Now in his eighth season with the ALJ Boys Tennis program, Craig D'Amico enters his first season as head coach. D'Amico served the last two seasons as an assistant coach under Michele Zaleski.

At only 21 years of age, D'Amico becomes the youngest head coach in the history of the program and the youngest serving head coach in Union County. He also becomes the first former Johnson Tennis player to return at the helm.

D'Amico enjoyed a stellar four year playing career in a Johnson Tennis uniform from 2000 – 2003. He was a four year varsity letter winner, the 2003 team Most Valuable Player, and was a part of two Mountain Valley Conference championship squads.

Following his playing career, D'Amico returned to the program as a manager in 2004 under Chris Raguseo, and then was promoted to assistant coach under Michele Zaleski in 2005. In the fall of 2006, D'Amico took over as the girls' tennis head coach for Kumpf Middle School.

CRUSADER NOTES

START ME UP

The Crusaders have now won eight consecutive season openers dating back to 2000. The Crusaders defeated the Oratory Rams to open up the 2007 season, 4-1, on 4/3/07. The last time Johnson defeated a MVC-MD foe to start a campaign was in 2004, a 3-2 victory at Governor Livingston.

WHO SAYS YOU CAN'T GO HOME?

The Arthur L. Johnson Boys Tennis Team plays all of their home tennis matches at the newly renovated Johnson Tennis Courts. The facility, which is located behind the Johnson High School in Clark, New Jersey, houses four regulation tennis courts and sits along the town reservoir. In recent history, the Crusaders hosted state playoff games at the JTC in 2001 and 2003, their first home playoff games in over a decade. The Crusaders went on a 25 home match win streak that spread over the course of nearly three full seasons (May 2000 - May 2003) and 1,097 days. Despite Johnson's 25 match home win streak ending at the conclusion of the 2003 season, the Crusaders still have maintained annual dominance at the JTC. In the 2004 and 2005 seasons, more than 60% of the team's total wins were at home. In 2007, Johnson will look to retain their annual JTC dominance with 12 scheduled home matches, the most since they played ten home matches in 2004.

WHEN YOU WERE YOUNG

For the first time since 2001, the Johnson Tennis varsity roster features no seniors, all 12 players on the roster are underclassmen. The Crusaders return five starters and eight letterwinners from last year's squad. In addition, the Crusaders welcome four newcomers: first year junior Ryan Couch, first year sophomore Brian Lutz, and freshmen Eric Ginocchio and Patrick Ozarek.

WE ARE FAMILY

Once again the tradition continues for brothers to come up through the Johnson Tennis program. Eric Ginocchio joins the Crusaders as a freshman where his brother, junior, Luke Ginocchio serves as the squad's third singles player. The Ginocchio brothers become the first set of brothers to serve on the Johnson Tennis roster at the same time since Craig and Alex D'Amico in 2003 and Brett and Drew Ashley from 1992-93. Other family ties amongst the current group of Crusaders include John Monagle, who's older brother Mike stands fifth on Johnson's all-time win list and Joe Broccoli, who's older brother Victor was a three year letterwinner in 2000 and 2002-03.

APRIL COME SHE WILL

The month of April has been very good to the Crusaders over the last few years. They hold a 71% April win percentage over the last five seasons. It includes a 10-1 mark in 2003, 7-6 in 2004, 5-2 in 2005, 6-2 in 2006, and 7-3 in 2007, for a 35-14 overall April record since the start of April 2003. ALJ has only lost seven times at home in the month of April during that same span; winning 18 of their last 25 home April matches at the JTC. This April ALJ dominance has resulted in the Crusaders qualifying for the NJSIAA State Team Tournament (a plus .500 record the first Tuesday in May) now in each of the last eight years.

DAY BY DAY

Johnson wrapped up their toughest stretch of games since 2004. For the week of 4/9 the Crusaders played four matches in five days, going 3-1 with victories over Rahway, Cranford, Plainfield and their only defeat coming at the hands of Dayton. It was the busiest week of Johnson Tennis since they played eight out of nine days from 4/15/04 - 4/23/04, with Sunday 4/18/04 being the only off day in that stretch.

FOR THE RECORD

Johnson's first doubles team of James Villari and John Monagle burst out to a historic start to the 2007 campaign. The started 5-0, surpassing the previous best start for a first doubles team in Johnson Tennis modern era history. Devin Felter and Chintan Patel went 3-0 to begin the 2002 season. No Johnson doubles team had ever before started 4-0. The duo rewrote more of the Johnson Tennis record books, by becoming the first Johnson doubles team in the modern era to qualify for the NJSIAA State Doubles Tournament. The competition will take place on Saturday, June 2, 2007 at Veterans Park.

In addition, third singles junior Luke Ginocchio started the 2007 campaign with a 5-0 record. The run was the best start to a season for a third singles player in Johnson Tennis modern era history, surpassing Mike Monagle's mark of 4-0 at third singles in 2002.

GET BACK

The Arthur L Johnson High School boys' tennis team officially clinched a spot in their eighth straight NJSIAA state team tournament with a 5-0 victory over Union Catholic. The victory improved Johnson's overall record to 6-2, which assured that they will have a .500 or better record on the first of May, the state cut-off date.

The state tennis pairings were announced by the NJSIAA on Tuesday, May 8 and has Johnson as the sixth seed traveling to the three seed Manasquan (8-3) on Tuesday, May 15th. It will mark the first ever meeting between the Crusaders and the Spartans.

Since the current streak began in 2000, Johnson has been eliminated by the eventual champion in four of the seven previous seasons. Johnson won a state playoff game in 2003, 3-2 over Madison, and has hosted a playoff game twice. Last season, Johnson received the number six seed and was ousted by the eventual Central, Group II champion, Rumson Fair Haven, in the quarterfinals for the second straight season.

SEEMS LIKE A LONG TIME

The Johnson Crusaders boys' tennis team posted their best Union County Tournament finish in five years as the annual county competition wrapped up at the Donald Van Blake Tennis Courts in Plainfield on Monday, April 30th.

Johnson finished with 11 team points, good enough for eighth out of the 16 team field, just one point behind Plainfield. The Cardinals earned all 12 of their points from the third place finish of their first singles player Addeton Osho.

The Crusaders eighth place finish is their best showing since placing sixth as a team in 2003, and marks only the fifth time in the last 15 years that Johnson has finished in the top half of the county.

Highlights of Day 2 included a 2 hour and 45 minute match between third singles Luke Ginocchio and Dayton junior Robert Krebner, the longest match of the tournament. Ginocchio would go on and finish in seventh place, the best finish for a third singles player since Mike Monagle placed fifth in 2002.

The Crusaders also set a new tournament record for most three set matches by a single team. Eight of Johnson's 17 tournament matches went the distance, with the Blue and White holding a 4-4 record in the three setters. Out of the seven wins Johnson earned during the course of the tournament, four of the seven were in three set matches.

Out of the ten matches that went three sets in the entire tournament, eight involved Johnson players. The two other three setters were between Chu and Angiuoni for the second singles championship and Vidal and Zerfoss in the third singles semi finals.

FOR THE FIRST TIME

Second doubles freshman Eric Ginocchio is off to one of the best starts for a freshman in team history. Ginocchio became the first freshman to reach double figures in victories since Mike Monagle recorded 18 as a freshman third singles player back in 2002.

COUNT TO TEN

In 2006, only the second doubles team of Alex D'Amico and John Monagle managed to reach double figures in victories. However in 2007, many Crusaders are on pace to exceed the double digit total. James Villari and Luke Ginocchio have already established career highs in single season wins. Villari had won seven matches in each of the previous two seasons before exceeding 10 this year. Ginocchio entered 2007 with nine career wins. He surpassed nine wins on the 2007 season alone with a victory over Roselle Park on 5/1/07.

Freshman Eric Ginocchio joined the list of Crusaders with 10 wins on the season with a 6-0, 6-2 victory at first doubles against Newark Technology on 5/3. Ginocchio's second doubles partner Brian Lutz clinched victory number ten with an 8-2 win over Oratory on 5/10. John Monagle also joined the group with his tenth victory of the season against Oratory on 5/10 at the first doubles position.

As a team, Johnson recorded their 10th win with a 4-1 victory over Oratory at the JTC on May 10th. It marks their first double digit wins season since going 11-10 in 2004.

SONG FOR JUNIOR

Johnson will have the opportunity to play in three JV matches during the course of the 2007 season. The Crusaders hosted Jonathan Dayton at the Johnson Tennis Courts on Monday, May 7th and Oratory Prep at the Brewer Courts on Thursday, May 10th. Coming up, they will host Governor Livingston at the JTC on Friday, May 18th. Freshman Joe Mignoli will serve as first singles, junior Joe Broccoli will serve as second singles, and sophomore Brad Brown will serve as third singles.

AT THE BEGINNING

Three Crusaders earned their first career varsity wins on 5/3/07 when Johnson welcomed Newark Technology to the JTC. Freshman Joe Mignoli, first singles for Johnson's JV team, earned a 6-0, 6-3 victory at third singles. Sophomores Brad Brown and Rob Perez earned their first career wins at second doubles.

Juniors Luke Ginocchio, Mike Keenan, and James Villari were named Johnson Tennis team captains for the 2007 season by Coach D'Amico prior to the start of the season.
